### **OFFICE NOTES**

#### Sub/Pizza Lunch on Bus Cancellation Days

Subs will arrive at the school on the regularly scheduled Tuesday if buses are cancelled (those students not in attendance will have their sub in the fridge for the next day. Pizza will not be delivered to the school until the next day that buses are running.

#### Absences

If students are absent from school for an extended period of time, (more than 5 days), the school will require the completion of a form "Request for Temporary Excusal". This form can be obtained from Mrs. Barks. If your child is going to be away from school or late, please call us and leave a message on our answering machine advising of the reason for the absence or late.

#### **Bus Cancellations**

As we are getting ready for another winter, this is a reminder that you can sign up to receive text messages/emails from the Transportation Consortium. These messages are sent if the bus is going to be more than 15 minutes late on any given day. Also, don't forget to listen to your local radio/tv for school bus cancellations. Buses that are cancelled in the morning will not be running in the afternoon. Remember-parents of walkers who do not attend school when buses are cancelled must call the school and leave a message advising that their child(ren) will not be in attendance.



If buses are cancelled, scheduled field trips, sports, tournaments and any other excursions outside of the school will be cancelled as well. The teacher will advise you of an alternate date.

#### **Cold Weather**



Cold weather is here! This is a reminder that students need to come to school prepared for the weather. All of us need to dig out our winter clothing, hats, coats, snow pants, boots and gloves! Students will be out for two 15 minute recess breaks as well as a 40 minute lunch break. The Simcoe-Muskoka Catholic District School Board follows the Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit (SMDHU) Cold Weather: Outdoor Safety Fact Sheet outlined on their website: "Keep children indoors if the temperature falls below -25C, or if the wind chill is - 28C or greater."
