October - The Month of the Rosary

The Church has always held Mary, the mother of Jesus, in very high esteem. She is called the Mother of God, Mother of the Church and our Blessed Mother. A few years before his death, Pope John Paul II encouraged families to rediscover this traditional prayer, the rosary, and to pray it daily for peace in our world.
