The Simcoe-Muskoka Catholic District School Board follows the Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit (SMDHU) Cold Weather: Outdoor Safety Fact Sheet oulined on their website: "Keep children indoors if the temperature falls below -25C, of if the wind chill is - 28C or greater."

School Buses - Are they running?

When buses are cancelled we ask that the parents of students who are not bused call the school if their child will not be attending school. Please go to <u>www.smcdsb.on.ca</u> and click on School Bus Cancellation Information or directly to <u>www.simcoecountyschoolbus.ca</u> All lates and/or cancelled buses will be on this website. Remember our zone, Central Zone. Radio stations for bus cancellations are B101 and Rock 95 You may also watch Breakfast Television on City TV. If buses are cancelled in the morning, they will not run in the afternoon. It is always the right of the parent/guardian to make the final decision when deciding if the road conditions are too bad for their child to go on the bus.

If buses are cancelled, scheduled field trips, sports, tournaments and any other excursions outside of the school will be cancelled as well. The teacher will advise you of an alternate date.

Thursday Pizza - Bus Cancellation Plans

If buses are cancelled on a Thursday (Pizza Day) the pizza lunch will be postponed until the first day that the buses run. Students coming in on a Thursday snow day must bring their lunches.


Reminder!
