VOLUNTEERING IN THE SCHOOL

If you have a current CBC on file, we will require the Annual Offence Declaration to be completed by yourself. Again, please contact Mrs. Barks for the form.



BREAKFAST CLUB

The Breakfast Club will be starting Monday, September 28th. For this to be a success we need your help and support. For those who are unfamiliar with the program, volunteers come in and prepare a healthy breakfast and can include such things as fresh fruit, cheese, yogurt, toast, pancakes or muffins. All students are welcome. If you are able to donate fresh fruit (the kids seem partial to strawberries, grapes and cantaloupe), fresh orange juice, eggs, yogurt or cheese that would be a big help. Or perhaps you are able to volunteer your time one morning a week from approximately 8 - 9:15 am, we would love the extra hands as we have fed 50-60 kids on the days that the Breakfast Club is open. CATHOLIC SCHOOL COMMUNITY COUNCIL

The following outline is from the School Councils Guide for Members, from the Ontario Ministry of Education:

Purpose

2. (1) The purpose of school councils is, through the active participation of parents, to improve pupil achievement and to enhance the accountability of the education system to parents.

(2) A school council's primary means of achieving its purpose is by making recommendations in accordance with this Regulation to the principal of the school and the board that established the council.

If you are interested in becoming a member of our Council, forms can be found on our school website or you can request a form from the office.

We are fortunate to have a dedicated group of parents however, we do require more parents on our Council. If you are new to our school, or have not attended a Council Meeting, come to our first meeting to be held on Wednesday, September 21st at 7:00 p.m. in our school library. We would love to see you! Elections will take place at this meeting.

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Office Notes

Safe Arrival

If a child is going to be late or absent, we ask that a parent call the school at (705) 737-9082 and leave a message on our answering machine. It is important that we receive a call from a parent/guardian and not the child or older sibling. If we don't receive a call that your child is away, we will attempt to reach parents/guardians using the numbers we currently have on file. If you have changed home, cell or business numbers over the summer, please advise the office of your new contact information.

Students Leaving School Property at Lunch

Please remember, only students in Grades 7 and 8 will be permitted to leave school property at lunch. **They must have a note written and signed by a parent each time.** Students will not be permitted to make a phone call from the school to request permission to go out with their friends at lunch. Students from Kindergarten to Grade 6 can only go out at lunch if they are picked up by a parent. This policy was implemented after discussions with our Parent Group.

Early Pick Up/Change of Plans

If you are picking your child up for an appointment, we ask that you allow extra time as we will call students to the office after you arrive. We are unable to guarantee that your child will remember to come to the office at the expected pick up time.

Transportation

Students who are on the bus are expected to take the same bus every night. Students are only allowed to go on the bus associated with the home address. Please remember that riding the bus is a privilege not a right. At no time can students switch between buses. Walkers are not permitted to ride the school bus at any time. Students who are listed as being on a bus will be sent home on the bus unless a note is received from the parent/guardian. Students are unable to make alternate transportation arrangements from the school. In the event of bus cancellations or bad weather please click the link on our school web page (bookmark: http://main.simcoecountyschoolbus.ca/) or listen to the local radio stations, B101 FM or Rock 95.7. This year you can sign up on the school bus website for alerts for your child's bus.

Cell Phones and Electronic Devices

Cell phones and iPods are not to be brought to school. In special circumstances students may need their phone after school, but they must leave their phone at the office during the school day and pick it up at 3:30. Students who are ill must report to their teacher and school staff will contact parents. There is no need for cell phones in classes or backpacks during the school day.

Medications

All medications for students must be maintained at the school office. If your child requires medication throughout the school day, please contact Mrs. Barks so that she may forward the appropriate forms for your completion. Medications cannot be kept in student backpacks. All medications must be in original packaging and cannot be given to students without the correct forms. Only new unopened bottles of non-prescription medicines may be sent to the school along with the appropriate form. For life threatening allergies or illnesses, the school will complete a Medical Plan after consultation with parents. Some injuries incur medical, dental or other expenses that are not covered by provincial healthcare or employer group plans. As a parent or guardian, you become responsible for those expenses.

We do make available the insuremykids® Protection Plan for students exclusively through Reliable Life Insurance Company. Participation in such a programme is voluntary and the costs are to be paid by the parent or guardian. The Student Accident forms are being sent home with this newsletter.

This program offers a variety of plans and benefits at affordable prices. Benefits included are:

- Dental expenses (resulting from an accident)
- Total and permanent disability
- Paralysis/loss of use
- Special disability benefits
- Eye glasses repair/replacement due to accident

Purchasing Student Accident Insurance is strongly recommended especially if your child participates in athletic or other cocurricular activities on or off school property. All students participating in extra-curricular teams, will need to sign a waiver that outlines whether they have purchased the insurance or are choosing not to purchase the insurance.
